was placed under scrutiny.

**Definition:** Requiring or using great effort

or exertion.

Synonyms: Arduous, Difficult, Hard, Tough

Antonyms: Easy, Effortless, Half-hearted

**Usage**: The government made strenuous

efforts to upgrade the quality of the

teaching profession.
