Usage: British Prime Minister Theresa May won a temporary reprieve on Wednesday as Conservative MPs backed her by a majority of 83 in a secret ballot.

Definition: Restore friendly relations between.

Synonyms: Reunite, Bring (back) together (again)

Antonyms: Estrange, Alienate

Usage: The king and the archbishop were publicly reconciled.

4. **Susceptibility (Noun)** - संवेदनशीलता

Definition: The state or fact of being likely or liable to be influenced or harmed by a particular thing.

Synonyms: Vulnerability, Sensitivity, Openness

Antonyms: Immunity, Resistance

Usage: Mr. Mallya's lawyers raised doubts about the CBI's independence, its alleged susceptibility to political interference.
