1. Protestation (Noun) – दृढ वाक्य
Definition: An emphatic declaration in response to doubt or accusation.
Synonyms: Declaration, Announcement, Statement, Profession
Antonyms: Acceptance, Agreement, Allowance
Usage: Her protestations of innocence were in vain.

2. Dilemma (Noun) – दुविधा
Definition: A difficult situation or problem.
Synonyms: Quandary, Predicament, Difficulty
Antonyms: Solution, Advantage, Benefit
Usage: The insoluble dilemma of adolescence.

3. Dispense (Verb) - वितरित करना
Definition: Give special exemption from (a law or rule).
Synonyms: Allocate, Allot, Apportion, Assign, Bestow
Antonyms: Collect, Include, Keep
Usage: The Secretary of State was empowered to dispense with the nationality requirement in individual cases.

4. Paraphrase (Verb) - संक्षिप्त व्याख्या
Definition: Express the meaning of (something written or spoken) using different words, specially to achieve greater clarity.
Synonyms: Reword, Rephrase
Antonyms: Copy, Transcript, Transcription
Usage: You can either quote or paraphrase literary texts.
